SUBJECT: U.S. Postal Service New Prices effective July 12, 2026

The U.S. Postal Service filed notice with the Postal Regulatory Commission (PRC) for mailing services price increases effective July 12, 2026. The adjustments raised mailing services product prices approximately 4.8 percent.

- The new rates include a 4-cent increase in the price of a First-Class Mail Forever stamp from \$.78 to \$.82. The additional-ounce price for single-piece letters has increased \$.29 per ounce.
- Metered mail has increased from \$.74 per one ounce letter to \$.78 per one ounce letter.
- Presorted mail up to 3.5 ounces has increased from \$.641 to \$.672 for mail processed in Carson City.
- Presorted letters up to 3.5 ounces have increased from \$.686 to \$.721 for the Las Vegas office.
- Presorted postcards have increased from \$.445 to \$.501. Full rate postcards have increased from \$.61 to \$.65.
- Flats (Large envelopes) have increased from \$1.63 to \$1.69 for a one-ounce letter.
- International postcards and letters have increased from \$1.70 to \$1.75.

Price adjustments were also applied to other First-Class Mail products, Periodicals, USPS Marketing Mail, Package Services and selected Special Services products.
