SUBJECT: Legislative Branch Vaccinations and Testing Extended through December

As you know, Impact Health offers free COVID-19 vaccinations in Room 1214 of the Legislative Building on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., and on Thursdays from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. This availability has now been extended through December 30, 2021. Please note that holidays are excluded (Thanksgiving, Family Day, Christmas Eve, and New Year's Eve).

Impact Health offers the Moderna, Pfizer, and Janssen/Johnson & Johnson vaccines and vaccine boosters without an appointment. COVID boosters are now recommended for all adults who are more than six months out from their last Pfizer or Moderna vaccination, and more than two months out from their Johnson & Johnson vaccination. Employees should bring their vaccination cards with them if they are receiving booster shots.

Additionally, Pfizer vaccines for children ages 5–11 are available beginning on Monday, November 29. Children's vaccines are available the same days and hours as adult vaccines.

COVID rapid testing is available in the lobby area adjacent to Room 1214 and the Senate Chamber on a walk-in basis or by appointment. Appointments for testing may be scheduled at <a href="https://www.impacthealth.com/nevadalcbtesting">https://www.impacthealth.com/nevadalcbtesting</a>. Those experiencing COVID symptoms are asked to remain outside the building and call for assistance. A nurse will come outside to conduct the test.
